

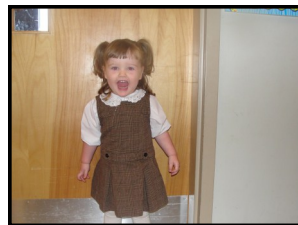


Nursery School News

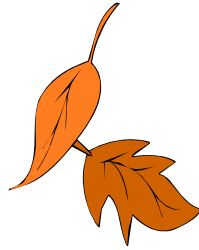
TOYWASHING

Free child care is available for children in our program if booked at least 3 days before the toywashing. The cost for siblings is \$5.00 per child.

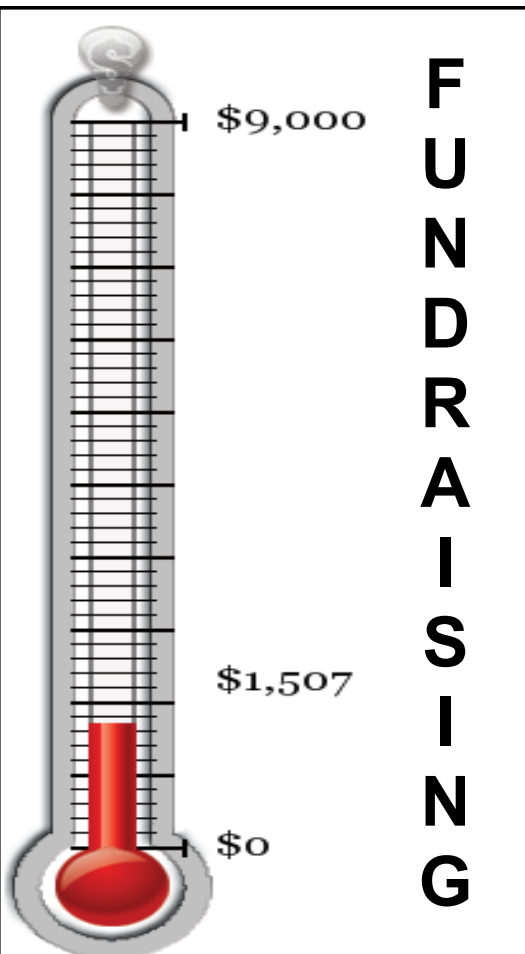
